Name	ABV	Brewery	Tasting Notes
Double Drop	3.70%	Flack Manor	A classic amber bitter with the full flavour of Maris Otter barley and the bitter citrus after tones of Sovereign hops
Flack Catcher	4.40%	Flack Manor	Clean distinctive rich golden ale with an initial sweetness, smoothly spiced with a crisp bitter finish leading to an old fashioned zesty linger
Finished	5.00%	Havant Brewery	A special bitter, conker coloured, made with added mollasses. The flavour has hints of coffee and caramel and traditional hops give bitterness and aroma.
Resolute	3.80%	Andwells	Takings it's name from a town within the high Arctic, Andwells Best Bitter combines the finest malt and hops to produce a well balanced malty and hoppy flavour with a light amber colour
Ruddy Darter	4.60%	Andwells	This ale is named after a deep red dragon fly found in local rivers and wetlands. The beer is produced using malted rye to give the characteristic ruby glow. A combination of English hops give flavour and aroma
Some Are Drinking	3.90%	Oakleaf Brewing Co	Light refreshing bitter with grapefruit flavours
Hole Hearted	4.70%	Oakleaf Brewing Co	Brewed with 100% Cascade hops. Powerful, floral and fruity beer will surprise with every mouthful!
Warbler	4.80%	Bowman Ales	A conker coloured premium bitter with an initial sweetness giving way to a dry chestnutty finish. Smooth, full bodied and fragrant. No birds were harmed in the making of this beer! A donation for each pint sold is made to the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust.
Elderado	3.50%	Bowman Ales	Hampshire Beer of the Year 2010. A subtle injection of elderflowers defines this beer. A hint of spring bloom, plenty of character with a bitter finish
Gold Spice	4.00%	Keystone Brewery	Multi award winning light coloured beer with plenty of late Boadicea hops and stem ginger added to the cask for a delicious zing of fresh ginger
TEA (Traditional English Ale)	4.20%	Hogs Back Brewery	A Classic Best Bitter, the Brewerys flagship ale, amber in colour with a hoppy and slightly fruity aroma, supported by malt in the taste . A bittersweet beer with a long dry finish.
HOP Golden Ale	4.60%	Hogs Back Brewery	A malty pale golden beer with hints of banana and pineapple, with a good balance of aroma and bittersweet hops giving a long dry finish with a sense of sweetness
Hobgoblin	4.50%	Wychwood Brewery	Traditional craft brewed with Chocolate and Crystal malts and blend of hops to produce a ruby beer that delivers a delicious chocolate malt flavour , moderate bitterness and an overall fruity character
Aspalls Suffolk Cyder	5.50%	Aspalls	Refreshing sparkling medium dry cyder with a floral fruity aroma
Traditional Scrumpy	6.00%	Westons	Hearty and wholesome cloudy cider, sufficiently strong to satisfy but not too sweet to smother the mature flavour of traditional bittersweet apples
